patients are killed annually by medical errors.

Cara Leigh Searcy was one of those 98,000 patients.

Cara Leigh Searcy, 4, of Scottsville, VA, needed one of her kidneys removed. The ureter from that kidney was re-attached to the remaining kidney. While still at the hospital, urine began leaking into her abdomen from the re-attachment. Her belly swelled with fluid, making it difficult to breathe. Despite several calls to the surgical team from her nurse, Cara was allowed to deteriorate for approximately 16 hours after her breathing difficulty was first identified. She died from cardiac arrest.
